



ANDT RULES FOR ÅKRAHÄLL SCHOOL

The main aim of **Åkrahäll School's ANDT rules** is to encourage individuals who are part of the school to refrain from **Alcohol, Narcotics, Doping and Tobacco**. A preventive campaign where information, education, drug testing, not to mention love and supportive frameworks, are important building blocks.

- These rules and the plan of action are presented to pupils and guardians at the start of school
- These rules regarding ANDT can be found on the school's homepage
- Alcohol and drug habits are discussed during lessons
- Pupils' absences are noted and followed up on
- Tobacco smoking and the use of e-cigarettes is prohibited everywhere on the school grounds
- It is forbidden to provide, store, or be under the influence of alcohol or drugs during school
- Symbols of drugs are not accepted within the school grounds
- When a pupil has access to one of the school's lockers or storage spaces, the school may examine the locker/space if it is suspected that drugs, alcohol or other items may be stored in the locker
- The school cooperates with social services and the police, among others. The school may use sniffer dogs in special circumstances
- For occupational health reasons and in our quest for a drug-free school with a safe school climate and favourable learning conditions, the school may conduct drug tests on teaching groups. The tests are voluntary, but they may be a requirement for a pupil to be able to take part in practical work and learning activities that involve a risk

These rules are developed in collaboration between pupils and staff at Åkrahäll School in Nybro. They are updated annually (rev May 2018/J.E)
